

DEVELOPING THE FUTURE OF FLIGHT!

Milwaukee County has initiated a Master Plan Update study for Lawrence J. Timmerman Airport (MWC). It will define a future development framework that ensures an organized and scalable plan to meet the demands of general aviation in the southeastern Wisconsin region.

As a designated reliever airport, MWC plays an important role in the state's aviation system. The Airport's Master Plan will describe MWC's future over the next two decades, meeting the requirements of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Bureau of Aeronautics.

What Does the Master Plan Entail?

The Master Plan Study Team will:

- ✓ Forecast the future activity anticipated at MWC
- ✓ Define the aeronautical facilities needed to accommodate that activity safely and efficiently
- ✓ Explore ideas for future facility layouts
- ✓ Evaluate overall development concepts
- ✓ Estimate the costs of and challenges with future development at MWC
- ✓ Document the planning process and conclusions

Milwaukee County's master planning efforts benefit from feedback and input by users and neighbors of the airport.

The Master Plan Process

The master planning process is guided by the FAA but reflects community and stakeholder priorities.



The FAA has approval authority at two specific points in this process:

Completion of the forecasts of aviation activity, and completion of the Airport Layout Plan that graphically depicts the planning conclusions. The process involves quantitative analyses, qualitative assessments, graphic concepts and strategic evaluations.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Forecast of aviation activity has been submitted for FAA approval. Trends show an increase in annual aircraft operations, but no significant increase in the number of aircraft based at MWC.
- Determination of the facilities required to safely and efficiently meet demand are completed. Initial results suggest there will be a need for hangar development, a general aviation terminal and self-service aircraft fueling.
- **Upcoming steps:**
Preparation and evaluation of alternatives for future development, review of potential environmental impacts, definition of a capital improvement program, second public information session and FAA review of future development plan.
